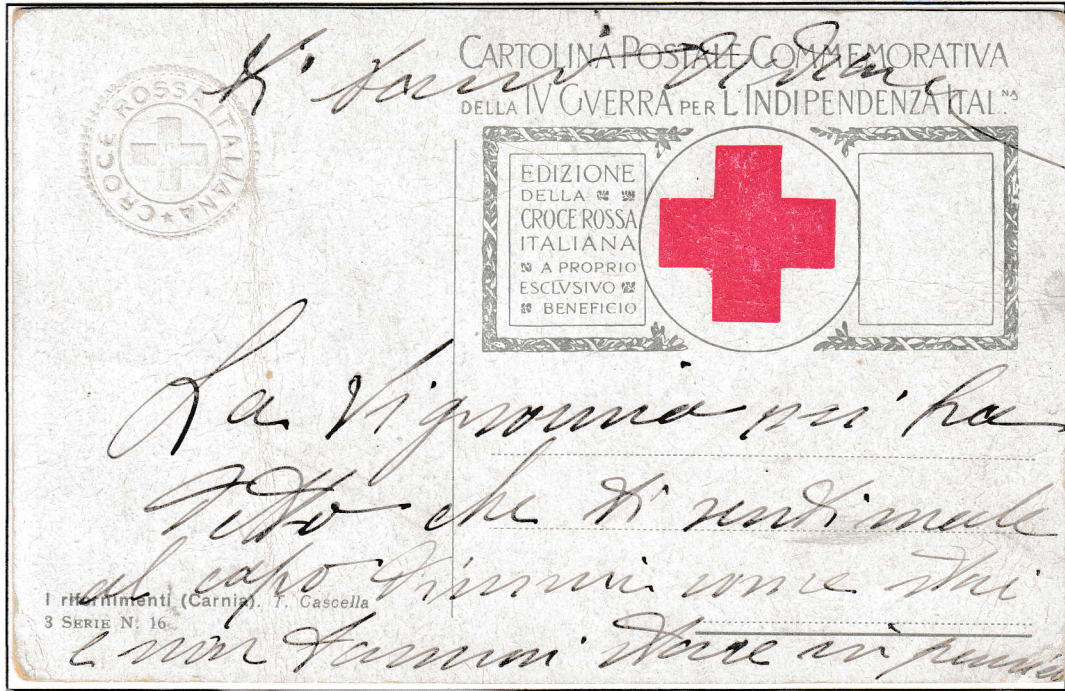

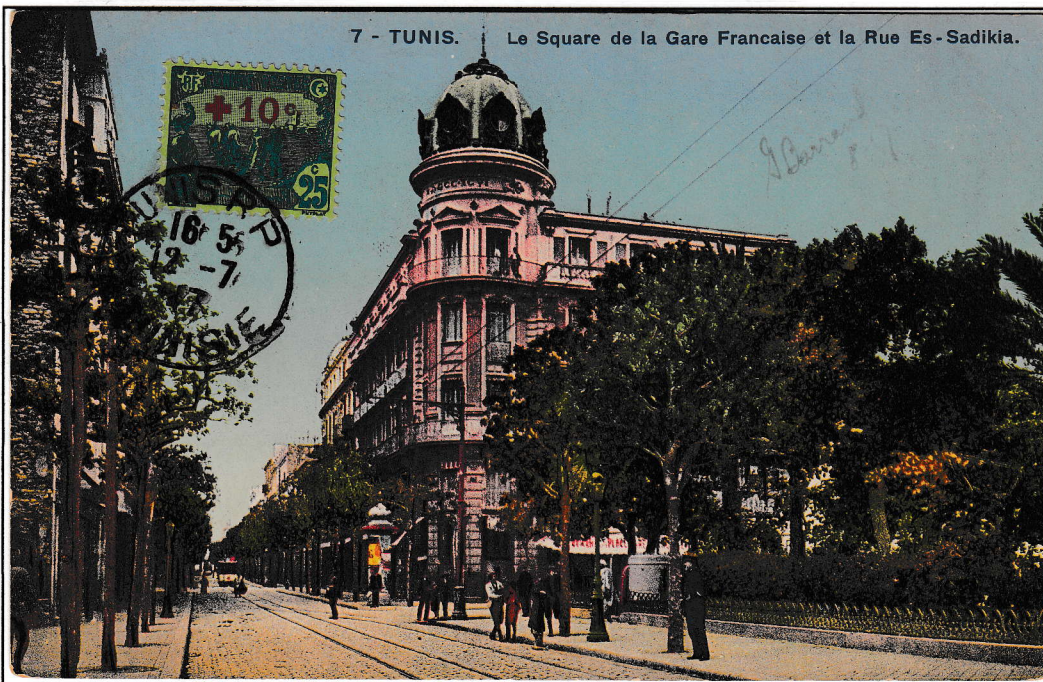

The Square de la Gare Francaise and the Rue Es-Sadikia are two streets in Tunis, the capital of Tunisia. The Square de la Gare Francaise is located near the Tunis Central Railway Station, which was built by the French in 1881. The square has a fountain and a statue of a woman holding a torch, symbolizing the light of freedom. The Rue Es-Sadikia is a street that runs parallel to the square, and it is named after Sadik Bey, a prominent Tunisian politician and journalist who lived in the 19th century.
